Six different pastors, Ed Hall, Bob Kells, John Mayden, Katie Mossburg, Dawn Reidy and Mary Jo Sims, have led some of the sessions. A special shout out to Pastors Mossburg and Reidy, who, although there were no confirmands from the churches they serve (Bunker Hill and Paynes Chapel, respectively), each lead one session.

During the ten session Confirmation class, we covered such topics as What is the Bible and how do we read and study it?; an overview of the biblical story of God; the doctrine of the Trinity; Jesus as God with us who restores humanity's broken relationship with God; What is the Church?; Prayer; the call to carry out God's mission and to witness to others; and Why be a part of the Church?

The Confirmation group also participated in a field trip to Strawbridge Shrine on either April 26 or May 10. The Shrine is located in New Windsor, Maryland and is the original home of Robert and Elizabeth Strawbridge. It was there that Methodism in America was first established as Robert Strawbridge rode a circuit and planted the seeds of what would become the Methodist Church in our country.

Immanuel's House

The Martinsburg Cooperative Parish helps to provide a meal on the first Monday of each month at Immanuel's House (713 Buxton Street, Martinsburg). They are open Mondays, 12 PM—6 PM, Wednesdays and Fridays, 9 AM—1 PM. They serve lunch every day, usually provided by Sister Acts or another church.

On Monday's, Immanuel's House delivers a hot meal to about 150 people. People gather there in the winter to get a hot meal and get out of the cold; they always have hot chocolate & coffee available.

Immanuel's House also provides assistance with paperwork, getting a driver's license/ID cards, financial, etc., to people in need. The MCP has about 8-10 volunteers that make the meals and help serve them. Menus are completed for the remainder of the year.

Reflecting on Resurrection

In Rest Your Dreams on a Little Twig, poet Joyce Rupp finds in spring flowers the proclamation of the gospel: "we who have died / are alive today." In another poem in the same volume, she writes: "A green shoot grows / out of an old tree stump, / announcing to the world / that power lies within death."

As you move about outdoors these springtime days in the northern hemisphere, where do you see nature testifying to resurrection? Where is evidence that what seemed dead — bare branches, dry grass, inactive seeds — was not in fact the final word? What encourages you to believe in renewal, second chances, life that blossoms from death? In what ways are you, who had died, alive today? Part of your life that felt like an old stump might be sprouting green shoots after all!




